1. Reason for the Establishment

Okaya & Co., Ltd. and KOGI CORPORATION established Tianjin Rainbow Hills Cast Iron Co., Ltd. in Tianjin, China in 2004 and have been manufacturing and selling automotive press mold castings since then. Now, the local demand is so large that the current production capacity of the company has been surpassed by the demand.

Also, since the explosion accident in Tianjin in August 2015, we have been reviewing the arrangement of our production system in case of emergency.
